

The Hangman

[A2-B2] Game rules

- One student plays the host.
- Host chooses the word or phrase the players have to solve.
- Host draws as many blank lines on the board as are the letters of the secret word.
- Players/teams start guessing the letters by asking: Is there a(n) ___ in your word/sentence?
- Host fills in the blank(s) with correctly guessed letter.
- Host draws part of the hangman for each wrong guess. The usual sequence is:
 - 1 Draw an upside-down L, the post where the man hangs from.
 - 2 Draw a circle under the horizontal line of the L: that's the head.
 - 3 Draw a line down from the bottom of the head: that's the body.
 - 4 Draw a line sticking out from the middle of the body: that's an arm.
 - 5 Draw the other arm.
 - 6 Draw one diagonal line from the bottom of the body: that's a leg.
 - 7 Draw the other leg.
 - 8 Connect the head to the post with a noose.
 - 9 Once you draw the noose the players have lost the game.
- The player/team who guesses the right word/sentence wins.
