

New meanings for old words

- **Bump (n.)**
 - 1 one of volleyball basics
 - 2 a raised swelling on a surface – a bump in the road/a bump on the head
 - 3 an accident involving a car
 - 4 the sound as of something falling on the ground
- **Bump (v.)**
 - 1 to hit something
 - 2 to travel over a rough surface
- **Bumpy (adj.)**
 1. having an uneven surface (for example, a road)
- **Set (n.)**
 - 1 one of volleyball basics
 - 2 part of a game of tennis
 - 3 a group of similar things or people
 - 4 a radio or TV
 - 5 scenery for a play or film
- **Set (v.)**
 - 1 put something somewhere
 - 2 to go down below the horizon (sun, moon, planets)
- **Set (adj.)**
 - 1 ready
 - 2 fixed
- **Spike (n.)**
 - 1 one of volleyball basics
 - 2 a narrow shape with a sharp point
- **Spike (v.)**
 - 3 a sharp rise followed by a sharp fall on a graph
 - 4 the antler of a young deer
 - 5 spikes – shoes used for particular sports with a set of short pointed pieces of metal fixed to the bottom
 - 6 spike heels – stiletto heels
- **Spike (v.)**
 - 1 to add alcohol/drug/poison to a drink
 - 2 to injury another athlete with the spikes on shoes
- **Spiky (adj.)**
 - 1 having sharp points like a cactus
- **Block (n.)**
 - 1 one of volleyball basics
 - 2 a solid lump of hard material with straight sides
 - 3 a large, tall building divided in flats or offices
 - 4 a large piece of wood or stone where people were beheaded in old times
- **Block (v.)**
 - 1 to prevent movement through – into – out of something
 - 2 to prevent something from happening
- **Blocked (adj.)**
 - 1 obstructed (a road, your nose if you have a bad cold)
